Scholars are eligible to apply if the following criteria are met:

- The scholar is a South African Citizen
- The scholar is academically talented and achieved 65% or above for English, Maths and Science on their Grade 5 Term 4 and Grade 6 Term 1 report
- The scholar combined household income is less than R 17,500.00 per month (Gross)
- The scholar is currently in Grade 6 (2021)
- The scholar lives in Cape Town, Northern Suburbs, Southern Suburbs, Helderberg, Boland area (Able to travel to Bellville on Saturdays for class)

**The selection process:**

- Once all applications have been screened testing will be arranged for those scholars who meet the required criteria
- Once testing has been completed successful candidates will progress to the next phase and form part of the Junior development programme and will need to attend classes on Saturdays at our offices in Bellville -This does not guarantee a scholarship.
- Scholarships will be awarded early in 2022 whereby scholars then form part of the High School Preparation programme and continue to attend Saturday classes at our offices in Bellville.
